The experience was both enriching and inspiring, leaving a lasting impact on all who attended.



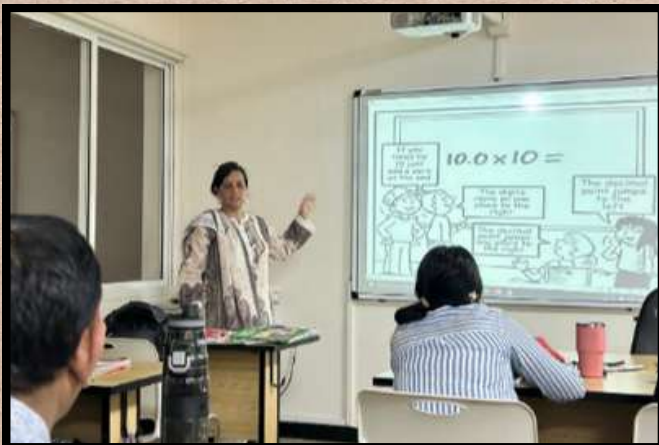

Experiential Learning-CLSP(Stage 8-Science)

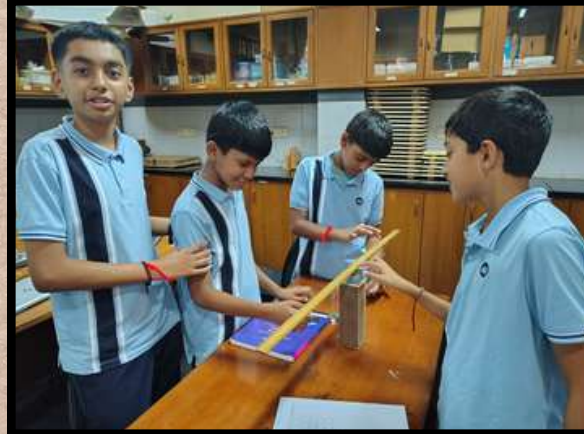

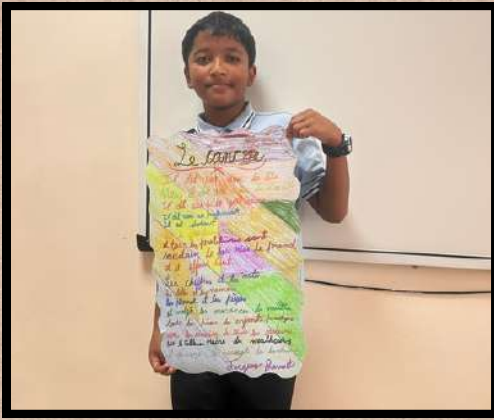
They built and tested their own see-saws, exploring balance, leverage, and mechanical advantage through hands-on experimentation.

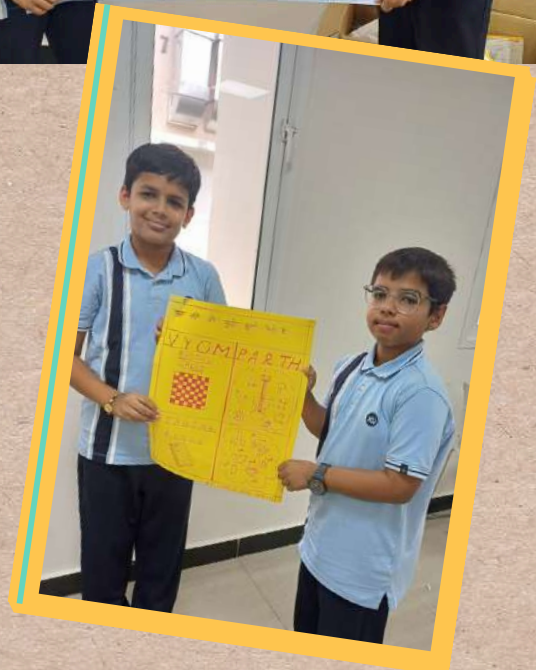
The students colored charts, recited the poem, and analyzed its meaning, enhancing their understanding of its themes while improving their French pronunciation, public speaking, and artistic skills.

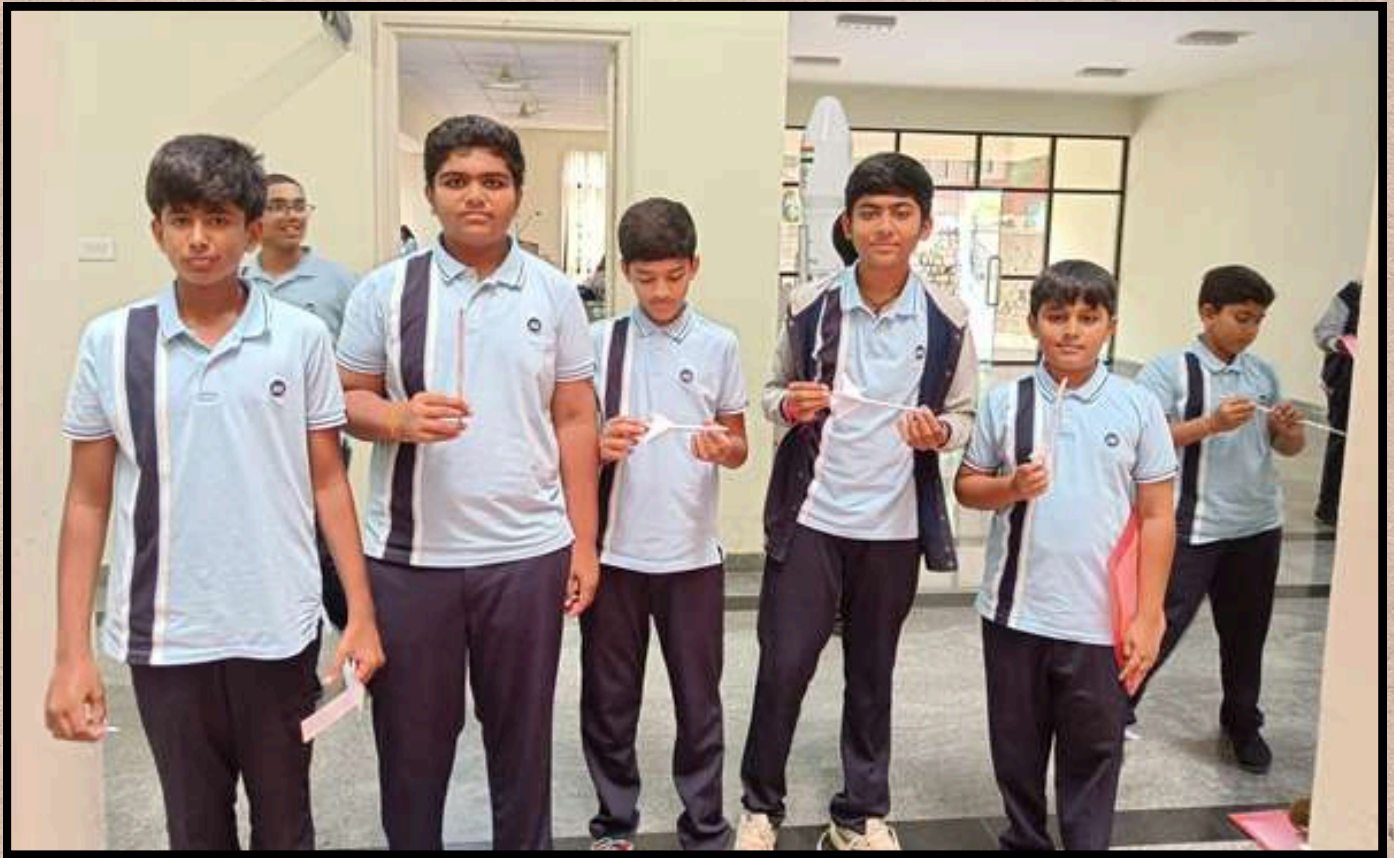

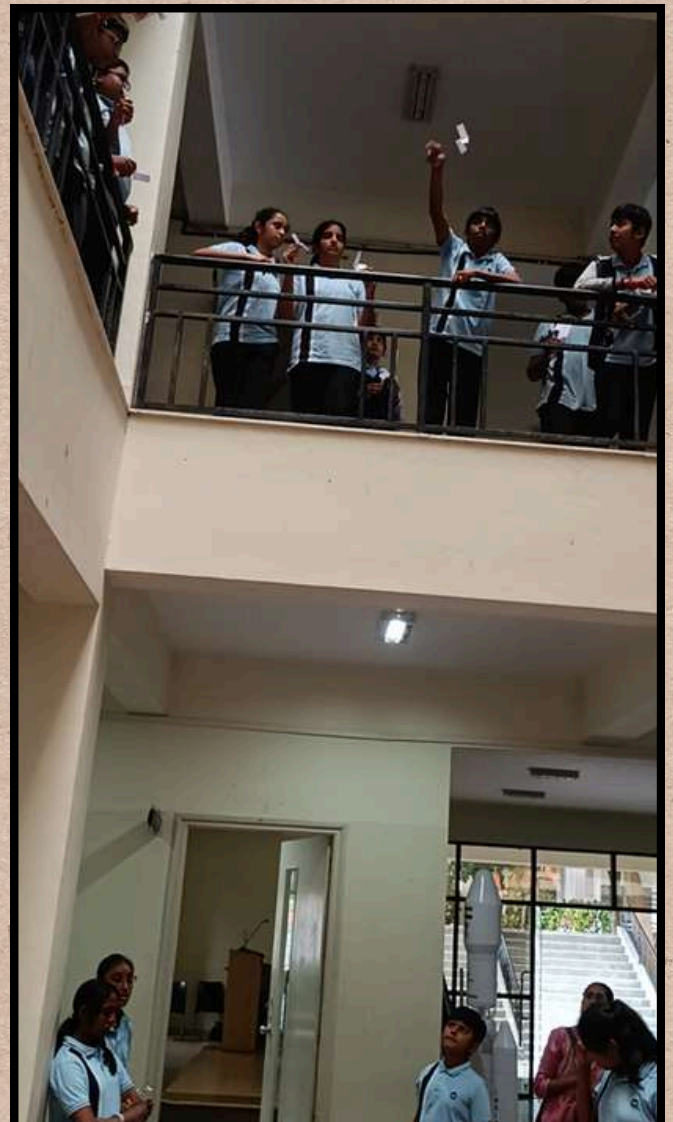

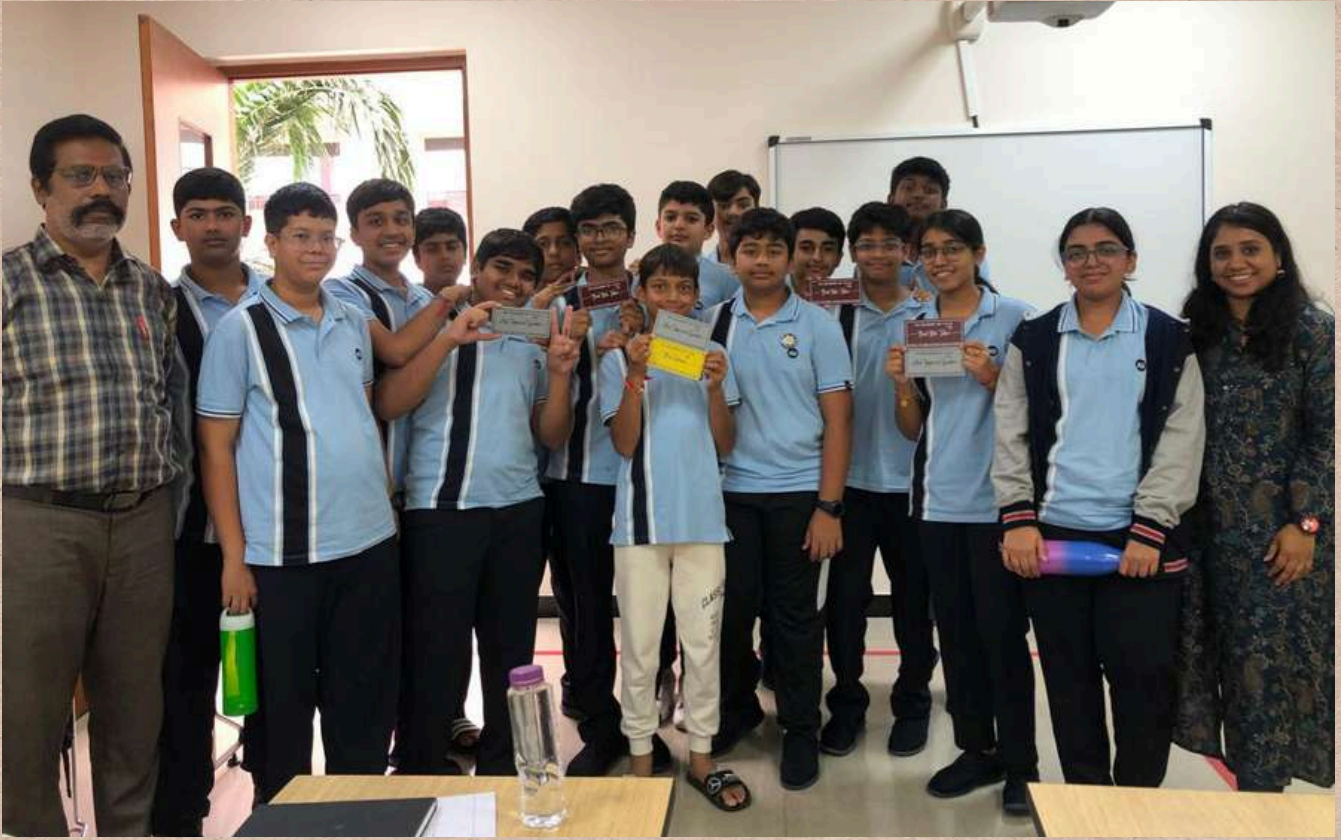
