It was a day filled with gratitude, joy, and memorable moments, truly showcasing the bond between our teachers and students.
















AMITY Club's Fundraiser event : Empowering Young




Jain Paryushan: A Time for Reflection and Spiritual Growth


Digging into the Depths of Soil: A Hands-On Exploration

Scaling New Heights: Wall Climbing Adventure!


On September 8, 2024, our students embraced the thrill of wall climbing under the expert guidance of Mr. Shadiq.

The action-packed adventure had everyone on the edge of their seats, providing a perfect blend of entertainment and camaraderie.


